



AUGUSTINAS SOKALSKI is one of the most perspective young cello players in Lithuania. Born in 2004, Augustinas started playing cello at the age of 5 at Algirdas Music School. Since 2014, Augustinas is studying at B. Dvarionas School of Music (class of prof. Tatjana Kuc).

A. Sokalski has won prizes in various prestigious national competitions and festivals, such as the Graduate Award at the 3rd National Cello and Chamber Ensemble Competition “My Cello”, the IInd prize at the 6th International Chamber Ensemble Competition “Musical Watercolors” and Laureate Diploma at the “Let's Make Music Together” festival.

Augustinas regularly performs at music festivals in Lithuania, including the “Ars Lituanica”, “Spring Passages”, “Opus Cello” festivals, and others. Furthermore, A. Sokalski is a member of the B. Dvarionas School of Music orchestra “Simfukai”, participating in extensive concert tours and projects around Lithuania.

Since 2020, Augustinas is a member of the New Ideas Chamber Orchestra NICO – string ensemble, founded by the Lithuanian composer Gediminas Gelgotas. Together with NICO, Augustinas has performed at prestigious classical musical festivals – Kintai Music Festival and Nomus Festival (Novi Sad, Serbia), as well as renowned Lithuanian concert venues – Palanga Kurhaus and Lithuanian National Philharmonic.
